Shop/Storage, Garden Storage:

Arsenic,

Poisons and rodent killer. Free Recycle Bins – The Recycling Department will distribute new recycle bins to Gary residents.

 The Gas Can Exchange Program - Bring in an old gas can to exchange for a new, environmental friendly 2.5 Gallon gas can. Gas cans are free, but you must bring in an old gas can to get a new one. The Gas Can Exchange Program is provided by NWI Clean Air. Limit one gas can per household.

Tire Collection – Residents and community clean up groups can collect and bring old tires for proper disposal.

Textile Recycling – Free tote bags for residents who bring a bag of clothing for recycling.
