## Lift Station Technician I

## **JOB DESCRIPTION:**

Responsible for performing maintenance functions related to wastewater, pumps, process systems and equipment, operating a variety of hand, power and shop tools, and driving/operating heavy equipment. Performs maintenance to ensure that wastewater is down and flowing, including maintaining bypass pumps and cleaning out catch basins. Empties grit and rag boxes as needed. Maintains areas around wastewater outfall, including mowing, weeding, edging, and tree trimming. Performs routine preventive and predictive maintenance, including but not limited to inspecting, cleaning, lubricating, and adjusting equipment, while keeping equipment in optimal working condition to minimize unexpected problems and downtime. Assists digging crew with locating manholes, catch basins, and gas lines, repairing/replacing catch basins, wastewater pipes, man-holes, cave-ins, and digging as needed. Performs related duties as assigned.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

High school diploma or GED. Must be at least 18 years old. Possession of a valid driver's license and demonstrated safe driving record Ability to obtain and maintain Class I Wastewater Collection System Operator certification or Class I Wastewater Treatment Operator certification within two (2) years. Working knowledge of and ability to make practical application of department safety policies and procedures and applicable OSHA safety policies and procedures. Ability to physically perform assigned duties, including sitting/walking at will, sitting/standing/ walking for long periods of time, lifting/carrying/pushing/pulling objects over 50 pounds. Ability to properly operate various hand and/or power tools, heavy machinery and equipment ,and standard office equipment. Ability to regularly work weekends, respond to emergencies on 24-hour basis, and serve on 24-hour call rotation basis from on/off duty status and occasionally work extended hours and evenings and travel out of town, but not overnight.
