# **Key Responsibilities:**

- Serve as the primary contact for media inquiries and public information requests.
- Plans, develops and monitors department goals/objectives in collaboration with GSD/GSWMD executive director and staff.
- Develops short and long-range plans to meet the objectives identified in GSD Long Term Control Plant (LTCP) and Consent Decree.
- Develop and implement communication strategies to promote the plant's activities, achievements and new business including trash collection.
- Prepare press releases, media kits, and other communication materials.
- Directs production of content, programming and editorial planning for all channels. Ensures professional production standards for video, graphics, animation and copywriting.
- Act as the spokesperson during crises, providing timely and accurate information to the public and media.
- Develop and implement crisis communication plans to manage public perception during emergencies or incidents Respond to emergencies on a 24-hour basis, including from an off-duty status, and work extended hours when necessary
- Actively engages with local, regional, and national media as required, to ensure accurate and favorable coverage of initiatives, projects, and statements.
