JOB DESCRIPTION:

Incumbent serves as Operator for Operations Department, responsible for a variety of operational tasks consistent with maintaining a safe and reliable operational of wastewater treatment plant. Performs operation of all mechanical, hydraulic, pneumatic, and electrical equipment and instrumentation, as directed. Performs a variety of laboratory analyses on wastewater samples from various processing units in the plant. Measures sludge depths in clarifiers, gravity thickeners, and digesters. Monitors dissolved oxygen concentration in aerators and final effluent. Records readings from sensors, gauges, instruments, and displays as directed. Performs necessary process control adjustments as directed. Observes safe methods for handling, unloading, and storing of all treatment chemicals. Documents operating data in plant operating logs. Monitors chemical inventory and notifies responsible staff when ordering levels are triggered. Assists in preventive and corrective maintenance activities as directed. Follows all on the job safety regulations including compliance with OSHA regulations, are followed. Performs related duties as assigned.

Possession of and ability to and maintain Indiana Class I Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator License.
